**THE RETIREMENT BENEFITS SCHEMES ACT 2000  
(APPOINTED DAY)(No. 1) ORDER 2001**

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Treasury by section 56 of the Retirement Benefits Schemes Act 2000<sup>1</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:—

**Citation and interpretation**

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Retirement Benefits Schemes (Appointed Day)(No. 1) Order 2001.
- (2) In this Order, “the Act” means the Retirement Benefits Schemes Act 2000.

**Appointed day**

2. The day appointed for the coming into force of the following provisions of the Retirement Benefits Schemes Act 2000 is 1<sup>st</sup> April 2001 –
  - (a) Section 37 (Constitution of Insurance and Pensions Authority);
  - (b) Section 38 (3) (Regulations made by Council of Ministers) and (10) (Practice and procedure of Review Committee);
  - (c) Sections 51 (Regulations and Orders); 52 (Financial provision); 53 (Principal Terms Defined); 54 (Interpretation – General); 55 (Amendments and Repeals); 56 (Short Title and Commencement);
  - (d) Schedule 1 (Insurance and Pensions Authority); Schedule 2 (Amendments of Enactments); Schedule 3 (Repeal of Enactments);
  - (e) and all other provisions of the Act but only to such extent as is necessary for the purpose of making public documents under the Act.
