

# Summary Roadmap for updating the Isle of Man's Regulatory Framework for Insurance Business – January 2019

## What is the current status of the project?

### Long term insurance

- New requirements in respect of risk-based capital, corporate governance and enterprise risk management and conduct of business implemented.
- Group supervision requirements for those insurance groups of which the Authority expects to be Group Supervisor currently in consultation.
- Discussion paper on public disclosure issued.

### Non-long term insurance

- New requirements in respect of conduct of business implemented.
- New requirements in respect of corporate governance and enterprise risk management implemented for commercial insurers.
- Final Quantitative Impact Study submitted by insurers.
- Ongoing discussions on captive definition.
- Discussion paper on public disclosure issued.

#### General insurance intermediaries

• All proposed new requirements (general business, conduct of business and governance) consulted on.

## What are the key milestones for 2019?

- Implementation of group supervision framework for long term insurance.
- Finalisation of captive definition and issue of regulations for consultation on risk-based capital for non-long term insurance together with updated reporting.
- Corporate governance code for non-commercial non-long term insurers consulted on and issued.
- Consultation paper on proposals for a public disclosure framework issued.
- All legislation in respect of general insurance intermediaries consolidated and issued for final consultation.
