>>> What are your main duties?

Everything we do at the Authority goes back to our statutory objectives of protecting customers, reducing financial crime and maintaining confidence in the Island's financial services sector. I work in the High & Medium Impact (HMI) Supervision Division and our team feeds into the objectives through the delivery of effective supervision of high and medium impact licenceholders.

>>> What are the most important qualities you need in your role?

Regulators need an extensive working knowledge of governance, risk management and compliance, in addition to the regulation itself. Strong analytical skills are a must. Regulators need to be able to quickly and accurately assimilate information, consider any associated risks and summarise effectively. Being a regulator also requires highly effective interpersonal (verbal and written) communication skills and the ability to deal with difficult or contentious issues. I also believe continuous development and learning to be crucial to the role of a regulator. With a rapidly changing social and economic environment it is essential to be able to keep abreast of emerging risk trends and to be adaptable and resilient.

>>> What do you enjoy most about working for the Authority?

During my time here, I have come to value the varied and interesting work. I find that routine can make us complacent, so I try to look for challenges that push me to grow, even after more than seven years at the Authority I continue to learn and develop.
