>>> What are your main duties?

Our Division is responsible for AML/CFT supervision of all licensed and registered firms, as well as AML/CFT policy matters and oversight of compliance with the Beneficial Ownership Act 2017. This involves desk-based and on-site inspections, holding meetings with firms, undertaking thematic projects, and risk assessing firms. In addition to the technical work, I'm also a people manager and part of the Senior Management Committee.

>>> What are the most important qualities you need in your role?

A high level of technical knowledge of the relevant legislation and guidance, strong analytical skills, good time

management, and effective people management. Being a team player is a core quality of working for the Authority; whilst tasks may sometimes be autonomous, a focus on the organisation's goals is always in the forefront of our minds.

>>> What do you enjoy most about working for the Authority?

I really enjoy being part of a team of great people who are focused on delivering a high quality of work in pursuit of the Authority's statutory objectives - it's a job where you can feel you're making a difference. I also love the variety that comes with working for the Authority – one day I might be presenting to industry, and the next I might be developing our inspection plan
